- 1. Parent initiates process by filing a grievance form. If the complaint is made orally, office staff will have the complainant fill out the form.
- 2. Once the grievance has been received, it will be sent immediately to the appropriate administrator (Director), who will contact the complainant in a reasonable amount of time.
- 3. If the issue is not satisfactorily resolved, an appointment will be made between the parents & principal. Attempts will be made to resolve the issue within 7 business days.
- 4. Internal process:
  - a. Complaint received
  - b. Time/date stamped
  - c. Immediate notification to Director and Principal.
  - d. Director will contact the complainant and investigate the complaint.
  - e. If Director cannot satisfactorily resolve the issue, the Principal will meet with the complainant to discuss complaint.
  - f. Documentation of above will be recorded
  - g. If issue is not resolved, complaint will be turned over to the district and will follow their procedure.
  - h. If complainant still dissatisfied, they may file a request to have a special magistrate assigned to their complaint.

NOTE: Special magistrate option is only available for specific matters covered by HB 1557.
