How to apply sunscreen

Sunscreen is safe and can protect your skin against skin cancer and premature aging. However, it is not as effective unless it's applied correctly. Follow these tips from dermatologists when applying sunscreen:

- 1. Choose a sunscreen that has an SPF of 30 or higher, is water resistant, and provides broad-spectrum coverage.
- 2. Apply sunscreen generously before going outdoors. It takes approximately 15 minutes for your skin to absorb the sunscreen.
- 3. Use enough sunscreen. Most adults need at least one ounce of sunscreen.
- 4. Apply sunscreen to all bare skin.
- 5. Reapply sunscreen at least every two hours to remain protected, or immediately after swimming or excessively sweating.
